Wow! We can hardly believe we are just a few weeks away from the end of another fantastic school year. The last day of attendance for 8th grade is Wednesday, May 22 (1:30 dismissal) and the last day of attendance for 5-7 grade is Friday, May 24 (1:30 dismissal).

2024-2025 online school registration is open. All students returning to D114 next year must register online through Skyward Family Access. If you register and pay in full by June 30, you will receive a \$20.00 discount **per child** toward their school fees. **See page 2 for more details.**

Save time and money by ordering school supplies online. The deadline to order is July 1. Supplies will be delivered to school on Meet and Greet Day next school year. **See page 6 for more details.**

If your child(ren) will be involved in athletics for the 2024-2025 school year, they must have a current physical on file *before* tryouts. Please try to schedule your child's sports physical over the summer so they are ready to try out for any activity. Keep in mind, cross-country, volleyball, and soccer begin as soon as school starts.

2045-2025 Returning Student Online Registration Opens May 1



Students returning to District 114 for the 2024-2025 school year must register online through Skyward Family Access. If you need assistance, contact the Lotus or Stanton School office. Early Bird Registration: Register online and pay your school fees in full by June 30, 2024 and receive \$20.00 off each child's school fees.

Returning Student Online Registration Directions:

Step 1: Log into Skyward Family Access *If you do not have your Skyward Username and/or Password, contact your school office.

Step 2: Click on either Lotus or Stanton located on the left hand side.

Step 3: Click on your child's name. (Each child must be registered separately.)

Step 4: Read the directions and carefully work through all items. Each field must be opened, completed, and the button at the bottom of each screen must be clicked to be complete and move onto the next screen. As each field is completed, a green checkmark will appear next to it.

Step 5: When all steps are finished, click "Submit 2024-2025 Registration.

CLEAR Residency System

District 114 uses an online residency system called CLEAR. The overwhelming majority of our families will be electronically verified. A letter will be sent to families whose residency we are unable to confirm electronically. The letter will provide details on additional information you will need to provide in order to register your child for the upcoming school year. Verifying residency is an effort to protect taxpayers and district resources by identifying non-residents attending District 114 schools. This process meets the requirements of the law while being more convenient for our families.



Medication

THIS YEAR: Medication kept in the school health office needs to be picked up by an adult no later than May 24 by the end of day. Any medication remaining after the last day of school will be properly disposed of per district policy.

NEXT YER: If your child will require Rx or Over-the Counter (OTC) medication, please have your doctor complete the district Medication Authorization form over the summer. You can submit this to school along with the medication to the front office/health office. ALL MEDICATION administered by the nurse in the Health Office must be done with a doctor medication order for each student including OTC.

6th Grade Requirements

ALL INCOMING SIXTH GRADERS: Are required to submit an Illinois Certificate of Child Health Exam form and vaccination record at the beginning of sixth grade. Illinois Law requires that any new student or sixth grade student without such documentation shall be excluded from school until submission of proof of health examination and sixth grade vaccines. **PLEASE MAKE YOUR APPOINTMENT NOW FOR A SUMMER EXAM** to avoid school exclusion in the fall. Absences resulting from this would be unexcused. As we approach the fall deadline appointments fill up quickly making it difficult to meet the deadline if an advance appointment has not been made.

SIXTH GRADE DENTAL EXAM: All sixth graders and new students are required to show proof of a dental examination performed after November 15, 2023. If this has already been completed you can submit the form NOW to the health office to meet the requirement.




